# The test for study, work and life

### What is IELTS?

IELTS assesses your listening, reading, writing and speaking skills. It helps you develop the everyday English you will need to study, live or work in an English-speaking country.

#### There are two tests:

**IELTS Academic** for higher education or professional training.

**IELTS General Training** for secondary education, migration, work or training.

If you are planning to study, work or live in the UK, you may need to take a specific IELTS test: IELTS for UKVI or IELTS Life Skills.
